Existing Wording

- **20**. (1) THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING SHALL BE HELD WITHIN THREE MONTHS OF THE CLOSE OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR.
 - (2) THE BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED AT EVERY ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING SHALL BE:-
 - (A) THE RECEIVING OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE'S REPORT AND THE STATEMENT OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE, ASSETS AND LIABILITIES AND MORTGAGES, CHARGES AND SECURITIES AFFECTING THE PROPERTY OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR THE PRECEDING FINANCIAL YEAR;
 - (B) THE RECEIVING OF THE AUDITOR'S REPORT UPON THE BOOKS AND ACCOUNTS FOR THE PRECEDING FINANCIAL YEAR;
 - (C) THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.
 - (D) THE APPOINTMENT OF AN AUDITOR.

 - (C) THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.
 - (D) THE APPOINTMENT OF AN AUDITOR
 - (E) THE SETTING OF FEES, HONORARIUMS AND MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATIONS

 - (C) ON BEING GIVEN A NOTICE IN WRITING OF AN INTENTION TO APPEAL AGAINST DECISION OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE TO REJECT AN APPLICATION MEMBERSHIP OR TO SUSPEND OR TERMINATE THE MEMBERSHIP OF ANY PERSON.

Proposed New Wording

- 21. THE SECRETARY SHALL CONVENE A SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING:-
 - (A) WHEN DIRECTED TO DO SO BY THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE; OR

SUCH REQUISITION SHALL CLEARLY STATE THE REASONS WHY SUCH SPECIAL BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED THEREAT; OR
 - (c) On being given a notice in writing of an intention to appeal against $\bf A$ decision of the management committee to reject an application membership or to SUSPEND OR terminate the membership of any person.

SAVE AFORESAID, IT SHALL NOT BE NECESSARY TO GIVE ANY NOTICE OF AN ADJOURNMENT OR OF THE BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED AT ANY ADJOURNED MEETING.

SAVE AFORESAID, IT SHALL NOT BE NECESSARY TO GIVE ANY NOTICE OF AN ADJOURNMENT OR OF THE BUSINESS TO BE TRANSACTED AT ANY ADJOURNED MEETING.

- (4) EVERY MEMBER PRESENT SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ONE VOTE AND IN THE CASE OF EQUALITY OF VOTES THE CHAIR PERSON SHALL HAVE A SECOND OR CASTING VOTE: PROVIDED THAT MEMBER SHALL BE ENTITLED TO VOTE AT ANY GENERAL MEETING IF HIS ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION MORE THAN ONE MONTH IN ARREARS AT THE DATE OF THE MEETING, AND HE HAS NOT ATTENDED LEAST TWO PREVIOUS GENERAL MEETINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION:
 - (5) VOTING SHALL BE BY SHOW OF HANDS OR A DIVISION OF MEMBERS, UNLESS NOT LESS THAN ONE-FIFTH OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT DEMAND A BALLOT, IN WHICH EVENT THERE SHALL BE A SECRET BALLOT. THE CHAIR PERSON SHALL APPOINT TWO MEMBERS TO CONDUCT THE SECRET BALLOT IN SUCH MANNER AS HE SHALL DETERMINE AND THE RESULT OF THE BALLOT AS DECLARED BY THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE THE RESOLUTION OF THE MEETING AT WHICH THE BALLOT WAS DEMANDED;
