That's \$30 in prize money every meeting night! No wonder there are more birds being benched! Isn't it time you joined in and made these Table Shows even bigger and more interesting.

The ANNUAL SHOW this year has been sanctioned as a 'CHAMPIONS SHOW', with a champion in Every Colour Class. That means that the Champion clearwing of Shpow receives the same recognition as the Champion Green or Champion Grey Green, as well as the same PRIZE MONEY. First in each of the 21 Colour Classes receives \$15.00, second gets \$10.00 whilst third receives \$5.00. That's \$30 total per each of the 21 Colour Classes. 
