Dear Members

This is a brief update on some of the recent events and decisions that our Club has been involved with in the past 3 months. It is also an appropriate time to be reminded about the OCTOBER BREEDER'S SHOW that is scheduled for NEXT SATURDAY! An updated Show and Class Schedule are included in this correspondence.

Before proceeding, all members of the Club will be saddened to hear of the passing of Robbie Stam, wife of long time member John. Four members of our Club attended the funeral, with life member, Roy Gourley, presenting the eulogy. John appreciated the support of the Club members in this challenging time.

Our MONTHLY MEETINGS continue to be well received with a greater emphasis on discussing many aspects of our hobby, particularly the breeding and exhibiting of our birds. Business is kept to a minimum. The TABLE SHOWS continue to be well supported and ensure that there are birds to be discussed. The meeting last Friday night was a good example of how open discussions are not only beneficial but enjoyable to the members and visitors in attendance. They wouldn't drive from the beach or Gladstone if that isn't true!!

A reminder that Table Shows have now been split into Beginner and Open sections, with the best any age, young bird and Nestfeather exhibit in each section receiving a \$5.00 voucher from the Club. That's \$30 in prize money every meeting night! The rewards have been shared around by those who are exhibiting at these Table Shows, with beginners enjoying success and an appraisal of their progress.

Memberships are due on 01 January (\$35) with a \$5 discount if payment is received before this date. Don't forget that next year's rings can be collected from our ring steward from December 15 this year and can be used from that date on. 2010 rings will be issued on 01 September 2009, hence the slightly earlier date in December. The Committee has decided that ALL members will receive 10 Derby rings with \$5 from member's subscription going into the DERBY pool. Members then have the opportunity to purchase an EXTRA 10 Derby rings for \$5 more. It is hoped that this will increase the number of birds entered to win the PRIZE money and the TROPHY in honour of late Life Member, Noel Shanahan. That's right, possibly 20 Derby birds and 20 chances to win!

<u>Please Note:</u> Club show rules must be strictly adhered to. <u>Proof of ownership must be produced for all winning exhibits</u>, CBS rings excluded. <u>Drinkers must be in show cages.</u> <u>Cage stickers to be adhered on the RIGHT hand side of cage.</u>

It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure all of their birds are nominated in the correct classes.

All birds entered must be Owner-bred.
