Dear Member

On behalf of the committee and all members of the Capricornia Budgerigar Society Inc., I wish you all the best for 2010 and beyond. 2010 certainly looks busy as we travel to Bundaberg for the Wide Bay Capricornia Inter Club Challenge Show (WBC), then host the 2010 Zone Shows and ANBC CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW! We all need to support the Committee who are planning this major event

A special welcome is extended to all of our new members. It would be appreciated if ALL MEMBERS forward their email addresses to me so that information can be forwarded quickly and efficiently. Note that our 2010 meetings commence in February.

Club meetings continue to have a major focus on discussing our hobby and the birds we keep. Lectures, forums, power-point presentations and discussions are scheduled and have been well received during 2009. These are outlined on the calendar of events enclosed with this letter. Some of the lectures that were planned but not given last year have been re-scheduled, whilst some new topics will be addressed. If there is a topic you'd like to present or have presented, don't hesitate to contact any of the Committee members. Bring along some birds to make the table shows interesting as well as giving yourself the chance to win the cash trophies awarded at each table show. These table shows also help train the birds on the judging process and prepares them for future wins. It also gives each of us the opportunity to have our birds assessed and their features highlighted for all to learn.

It's not long to our ANNUAL SHOW (schedule included). The DERBY winners will share over \$100 this year. THIS SHOW will also act as our selection for the WBC with both OPEN and BEGINNER Young Bird sections being combined at this Show. Cocks and hens will be judged separately. To allow members to bring more young birds for selection, members may re-use show cages from the Any Age and Nestfeather Sections (only the winners need to stay in their cage for final judging of major awards at the completion of the Young Bird Section. Other exhibits may be placed in a stock cage and the Show Cage re-used by young birds for the next class.) To further encourage more young birds to be brought, all exhibitors will pay a maximum of \$10 entry fee to cover all their entries. Bring a stock-cage full of young birds and keep re-filling those show cages! Note that the WBC is held on March 27 & 28 this year!

Invitations have sent to breeders to nominate birds for our Annual Auction, with more top line breeders requesting to be a part of this year's event. All CLUB members may enter up to 8 birds. A letter is enclosed in this mail-out. Put those best culls aside for this great event. Nominate before April 16! The sooner nominations are received the sooner the catalogue can be distributed. It will be good to have them available when our 300+ visitors are here for the Nationals.

Trust this finds you well and looking forward to an exciting 2010. We look forward to seeing you at a Club event. Thank you for your continued support.

Benching: by 9.45 am

Judging: 10.00 am

All persons responsible for winning exhibits must be present for checking of rings on completion of judging or exhibits will be disqualified.

Presentation of Trophies: Approximately 15 minutes after completion of judging.

Release of birds to follow presentation. Chief Steward will advise time.

<u>Please Note:</u> Club show rules must be strictly adhered to. <u>Proof of ownership must be produced for all winning exhibits</u>, CBS rings excluded. <u>Drinkers must be in show cages</u>. <u>Cage stickers to be adhered on the RIGHT hand side of cage</u>.

<u>It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure all of their ANY AGE birds are</u> nominated in the correct classes. All Nest feathers are entered as CLASS 401

All birds entered must be Owner-bred.

Dear Member

Following the great success of the 2009 Winter Auction, our Club is again conducting a major Auction on the Queen's Birthday weekend (June 13). Birds from top southern breeders and exhibitors as well as from local Zone fanciers will be assembled. It is anticipated that many fanciers from Cairns to the Gold Coast will be attending, as well as several well known inter-state exhibitors. The venue for this year's auction is the Performing Arts Centre, North R'ton High School, Simpson Street, North Rockhampton. Off-street parking from Simpson Street is available.

It is with great pleasure that we invite you to submit birds for benching at this event. It is expected that birds offered will be no more than 2 years of age (rung 2008/9), and that freighting to and from Rockhampton will be organised and paid for by you. However, care of the birds, show cages, benching, etc will be fully organised by the Capricornia Budgerigar Society Inc. (CBS Inc.). The CBS Inc. will retain a 10% commission on the selling price. An entry fee of \$1 per bird also applies.

As part of our advertising we wish to place a catalogue on our club web site to generate interest. It would be appreciated if you could **provide details on the attached proforma** and **return this to me by** Friday **April 16**. This should ensure that the catalogue reaches cyberspace and can be posted to the fanciers in many Queensland Clubs by the end of April. A photo of a nominated bird or birds can be included for possible use in the catalogue.

It would be appreciated if you could advise me as soon as possible if you are able to provide **up** to **eight birds**. If you are unable to supply birds then these can be re-allocated as we are limiting the lots to approx 200 to 240 and the demand for lots in this event is strong.

We have also organised a 'Pre-Auction' Meal and 'get-together' on the Saturday evening. This has been well patronised in previous years. It is an enjoyable function and a great opportunity to have a good feed and a great chat to many of the top local and visiting breeders. It's a chance to learn a few trade secrets as well as get some inside information from the breeders of some of the birds being auctioned the next day.

Thank you for your consideration and support. I look forward to your reply and a profitable and successful auction.
