CCBFA Feathered World Article

2020 is sure to be a big year in terms of government matters. A bit of a taste of what's to come...

- I'm already presenting at 2 parliamentary inquiries in NSW (in my role with Animal Care Australia (ACA)). One on animal cruelty laws (Feb 13) and another on exhibited animals (April). Both are in response to the Animal Justice Party (AJP) who currently has 2 upper house members in NSW and 1 in Victoria. The AJP is essentially the pollical arm of the extreme animal rights movement. Their current policy is to have NO birds in cages of any type.
- Native animal licensing will need a real push this year to get sorted. I've been in contact
 with managers of the process in both NSW and WA to get updates. NSW has stalled and
 I'm waiting on a meeting with the Minister. The WA consultative committee sadly
 remains a work in progress as well. The ACT matters also will need finalisation. Qld's new
 system is supposed to begin in April, but experience in other states indicates we must
 keep some pressure to ensure timely implementation.
- Animal Welfare legislation in both NSW and Victoria is undergoing major revisions that
 commence in earnest this year. CCBFA is overseeing all aspects of these reviews. Victoria
 is in the process of employing a team of contractors to work on their revisions and I've
 already had a few promising discussions with the manager overseeing the process.
 Similarly, in NSW, we have already met in Sydney with the DPI team examining the
 overall goals and we put forward ideas we'd like to see in any revised animal welfare
 legislation. We must be vigilant in this area as the influence of the AJP and other animal
 rights groups should not be underestimated.

We encourage all clubs to send delegates to our meetings and would particularly value input from any of your members who may have experience dealing with government or with a legal background. Currently there really is quite a small team leading the charge nationally so any expertise in this area within aviculture would be greatly appreciated.

All birds entered must be Owner-bred.

- Proof of ownership must be produced for all winning exhibits, CBS rings excluded.
- Show cages to contain a standard seed mix. Drinkers must be in show cages.
- Cage stickers to be adhered on the RIGHT hand side of cage.
- It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to ensure all of their birds are nominated in the correct classes and mark cages accordingly.
- Club show rules must be strictly adhered to.
