Open breeders take note, there is some beginner breeders pushing you for the top spot with some truly excellent birds. Great to see them do so well in the results. Full results appear further in the newsletter. Thanks also to our visitors from Mackay and Frazer Coast.

Please note our April general meeting is the second Friday of the month (14/04/23) due to the first being Good Friday. Rod Vidler will be giving a talk on breeding and showing Spangles and Dominate Pieds at this meeting.

Next event coming up for us is our clubs Young Bird Selection Show held on May the 13th to be held at the bird pavilion Mt Larcom showgrounds. Show schedule appears in this newsletter. Please DO NOT spot your birds for this show, but make sure they are clean (bath if necessary) and free from external and internal parasites. A fortnight later is the QN&C zone selection show. If you have birds selected to go to this selection, please remove the small upper spots but DO NOT remove the big main spots, the carers will dress the birds fully before the Nationals if you are successful in qualifying birds. If in doubt leave alone.

Good luck to everyone trying to qualify birds for the Nationals and after seeing the young birds at our recent show I think there will be quite a few beginner birds qualifying. I urge all members to enter birds even if you think they may not be good enough, let our judges make that decision. It's an honour to get birds to the Nationals.

Special Conditions of Show

All young birds entered in Young Bird classes must be available for selection in the CBS Inc. team to contest the Zone Championship Show.

The first 3 placings are automatic selections.

Major trophies & variety trophies as listed in this schedule are for Young Bird Classes only. All persons responsible for winning exhibits must be present at the completion of judging for checking of rings otherwise exhibits will be disqualified.

Club rules must be strictly adhered to.

Exhibitors are reminded that the responsibility of having birds entered in the correct class is their own.

The hen's class will be judged first, with the first three hens being awarded those positions. The remainder of the hens will be re-judged in their respective variety classes. The owners of the second and third placed hens have the option of returning these respective birds to their variety class at the conclusion of the hen's class. Their decision at this time is final.

All birds entered must be owner bred with birds entered in Young bird classes being 2022 rung (Brown Rings)
