For those that don't know Maarten is from Belgium and was the overseas judge at the Nationals. The cinnamon hen has been a winner for Ray, the grey hen is very young and has just broken its cap. The grey hen will not be a show bird because of it's flecking but will make a valuable stock hen. I Hope this shows us where we need to be heading and how much we need to catch up.

In Maarten Heylen's talk at the Nationals he described our birds as still having 2 circles on the face. He said we need to try and get the face as one circle.

The cinnamon hen has 2 circles. The Grey hen still has 2 circles but is getting very close to the one circle Maarten was describing. Very good feedback on this hen when he visited.
